The purpose of this meeting is discuss the Forrest Monument with Attorneys' Gamble, Gamble & Calame.

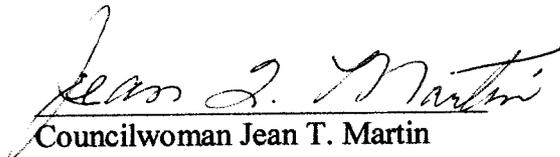

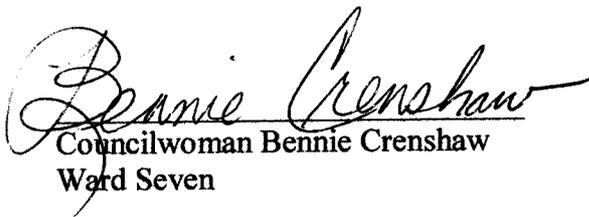

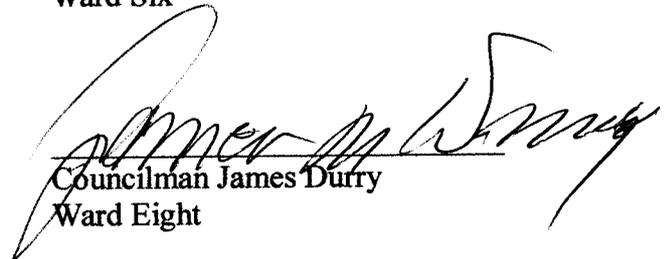

MEETING HELD ON WEDNESDAY, APRIL 2, 2003

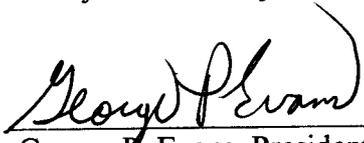

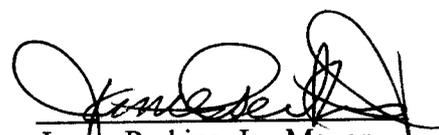
There being no other business to come before the Council, on motion made and duly seconded, the Council voted by unanimous consent to adjourn at 4:10 p.m.
