Call to Order

Invocation: Councilwoman Jannie Venter

The Selma City Council met in a special called meeting to certify the election results in the Council Chambers of City Hall on Tuesday, September 2, 2008 at 12:00 noon.

**ROLL CALL**

The following members were present during roll call: Council President George Evans and Council members Cecil Williamson, Reid Cain, Jean Martin, Johnnie M. Leashore, Bennie R. Crenshaw and Jannie M. Venter. Others present were City Clerk Lois Williams, City Attorney Jimmy Nunn, and the Mayor's Executive Assistant Darlene Rudolph. Councilwoman Allen arrived shortly following roll call.

President Evans stated that this meeting has been called for the purpose of discussing the items listed on the agenda before you; to canvass ballots, certify election held on last week, August 26<sup>th</sup> and approve bid for a police vehicle.

**BUSINESS ITEMS:**

**I. Resolution #R226-07/08 - Bid Approval for Police Vehicle (2007 SUV)**

President Evans asked the Council's pleasure for this resolution. A motion was made by Councilwoman Venter and seconded by Councilwoman Martin to approve the bid award to Moore-Stewart Ford Company in said resolution in the amount of \$16,000.00 to purchase a police vehicle. A roll call vote was taken and the motion passed with a unanimous vote of the Council members present.

**II. Canvass Ballots**

Canvassing of the provisional ballots facilitated by City Clerk Lois Williams and City Attorney Jimmy Nunn. During canvassing, a total of 30 provisional ballots were submitted to the City Clerk by the Board of Registrars Office to be counted. Each ballot was reviewed by the members of the Council present.


Councilman Leashore and Councilwoman Crenshaw are now absent from the Chambers.
